

THE ONLY NATIONAL WOMEN MACHINERY IN EGYPT

According to law no.30 year 2018, is the mandated national women's machinery in Egypt, to propose responsive policies to women needs, legislation, action plans as well as conduct training programs and awareness raising mechanism for women. It has 27 active local branches that work closely with communities and community women leaders. It has reached out to 52 million beneficiaries (outreach) on ground in the past 5 years.

AFFECTED WOMEN SEGMENTS

- Women at reproductive age
- Women with immune diseases or chronic diseases
- Elderly women; women in need and with less access to urban services
- Women with disabilities
- Women with health conditions (pregnant/lactating women)

AFFECTED WOMEN SEGMENTS

- Women in fragile and informal work sectors including temporary contracted women, domestic workers, street vendors)
- Women at orphanage and elderly shelters
